We are a grassroots movement that grew from the horrific elder abuse of 17 individuals at a memory care facility in Lewisburg, Pennsylvania in 2023. Lynn Fiedler, the founder of the movement, is the daughter of Alice Longenberger, one of the abuse victims. The group was organized after realizing the lack of protections and the injustices of current state laws. Our 503(c)(3) non-profit organization has fought tirelessly to change the laws and create new ones with the introduction of three new bills in Harrisburg, including Alice's Law. Much progress has been made with the support of Senator Lynda Culver and Journey to Justice group members.
